It started in Akron over 12 years ago and now has 6 or 7 locations throughout the rural areas where public transportation is limited. Volunteers are the forefront of what Hearts and Hands does for this community. Getting to know and help people in the community is a real fit to what we've been talking about and doing at CCAM Church as we intentionally try to be more missional in our thinking and reaching out to those in need. You make it all happen by driving your neighbors to Dr. visits, shopping or wherever else they need to go, doing light housekeeping, taking a care recipient to a social activity, Caregiver Respite, companion visits, laundry for someone, being a phone pal, taking someone for coffee and conversation. Help is needed on all these levels, especially for drivers in Akron and Alden. Before you start helping you go through a short training seminar to answer any questions you may have about some situations you may encounter. Personally I drive for Akron and Alden, and after going back after a six month rest after surgery, this one lady in Alden was so thankful to see me again as she hadn't been shopping in 4 months. Neighbors picked up a few things for her a couple of times but she really needed to shop for herself. This is the only time she gets out every month and I feel so blessed to be able to do it. You always have the option to say no when contacted if there is a scheduling problem or you're not feeling up to it that day.
