

What to Bring to Beaver Camp

If you are staying in a CABIN:

- Bedsheets
- Note: most cabins have 1 double bed and the rest single
- Pillows
- Bath towels (wash clothes, hand towels and shower towels)
- Shower supplies
- Sneakers (a recommendation if doing challenge course)
- Swimming/Beach supplies (suit, towel, sand toys, shoes, sunscreen etc.)
- Fishing pole (fishing license needed if over 16 years of age)
- Drying rack (if preferred)
- Fan
- Rain gear
- Lawn chair

Note: Try to be very careful with keeping food/snacks in your cabin. Please keep in coolers or sealed totes. Thank you.

If you are in a MOTEL UNIT:

- Unit has a 1 double bed - sheets provided
- Unit has 1 set of bunk beds - single sheets or sleeping bag is needed if using bunk beds.
- Small refrigerator & Microwave are provided
- Towels and washcloths are provided.
- You will need shower supplies
 - o Fan (if desired)
 - o Beach supplies
 - o Lawn chair(s)
